## Week 33 – Acts 11:19-30 An Urgency of Presence to One Another

Most people understand being a "good Christian" as following Jesus, knowing Jesus, and relating to Jesus. This has led many people to the (wrong) conclusion that they can be a "good Christian" without being connected to a church. Today, 80 percent of Americans say they can be what Jesus intended them to be without being connected to a church, a body of believers. The truth is, Jesus lived and breathed and did everything He could to create a *community* of people called the church.

- Ephesians 1 says He rules all things for the church.
- John 17 says He sanctified Himself for the church.

The church is a big mess with all kinds of craziness, but we can't get rid of it, because Jesus died and rose for it.

How do you feel about "the church?" (not Element per se, but the universal Church?) List both negative and positive.

How can the perception of the Church be changed from an institution to a community?

The church is meant to be like God's hands and feet to the world; this idea has been called "the importance of presence." What did the early church do? They sent letters, but they also sent prophets and apostles to be physically present to the church in Antioch. Why did they do this? Because God did the same thing for them. Jesus came in the flesh and they realized God was sending them "in the flesh." God's presence affects the world through His power, but also through His people. We must become aware of how God now sends us as HIS PRESENCE in the world.

Are there any places God is calling you to in order to be His hands and feet to?

If your life is meant to be part of God's message to the world, what message are you sending?
