MISSION



GENESIS THE FINAL CHAPTERS: PART 67 MONEY AND STUFF

Matthew 6:33 "But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."

It's one thing to use your money on selfish things when you are single; it's a whole different story when you are married, then with kids, and put them in Debt.

So how do we make things better?

- First, own up to your mistakes- Apologize. Ask God for His spirit of conviction and His help to break the spending desires.

- Third, get some financial and spiritual help. It's not about how to get rich, it is about managing your money in a way that honors God.

FINANCIAL PEACE UNIVERSITY CLIFF NOTES.

1. Step #1 - Save \$1,000 for emergencies.

When the emergency comes, you don't use the credit card, you use your emergency fund. Then replenish it.

2. Step #2 - Make a budget._

You need to know where your money is going. (SEND AN EMAIL TO FPU@OURELEMENT.ORG AND ASK FOR ONE). You must also understand how God fits into your budget, everything we have is a gift from Him. We are stewards...if we understood that, it would changes how we budget and spend.

3. Step 3 - Cut the cards.

Now that you have the emergency \$1,000, you don't really NEED the credit card. This will take some trusting in God (and possibly doing without).

4. Step 4 - Dumping debt

When you are done paying off Debt and before you take that money and start paying off the mortgage, FPU says put 3 months of expenses into savings, as a stronger emergency fund. Because we all know stuff happens. Then roll the money to paying off the mortgage.

5. **Step 5 -** The Great Misunderstanding.

God is clear on giving, He doesn't need our money, but there are a number of reasons we give. Bottom line He commands it because He knows WE NEED IT. It makes our hearts more receptive to being generous, it helps us trust Him more, and we get to see His resources help others.

Money is a very spiritual thing, we are just being the stewards.
