WORK, LAZINESS, SLUGGARD PART I

WORK, LAZINESS, SLUGGARD PART I

Welcome to Element! We are working our way through the book of Proverbs, which is a wisdom book in the Bible. Today we are going to be talking about Work, Laziness, and Sluggards! I know, you are probably thinking that you already work Monday through Friday (or more) and may not really be interested in hearing more talk about work. However, what the Bible says about work is very important and the idea behind the book of Proverbs is that it allows us to live in the freedom of Christ, which is a pretty counter cultural idea.

Biblical Principals about work:

- Proverbs 11:1 A false balance is an abomination to the Lord, but a just weight is his delight."
- Proverbs 22:29 Do you see a man skillful in his work? He will stand before Kings; he will not stand before obscure men.
- Proverbs 12:24 The hand of the diligent will rule, while the slothful will be put to forced labor.
- Proverbs 20:14 "Bad, bad" says the buyer, but when he goes away, then he boasts.
- Proverbs 16:26 A worker's appetite works for him; his mouth urges him on.
- Proverbs 27:18 He who tends a fig tree will eat its fruit, and he who looks after his master will be honored.
- Proverbs 26:13 The sluggard says, "there is a lion in the road, a fierce lion roaming the streets!"

The book of Proverbs is very practical in its wisdom. We are told to be fair, work with skill, improve on what we have been given, be motivated, and be a blessing in how we work.

There are very few jobs that are "non-Christian Jobs," a Christian can do all jobs and it is foolish to not take a job because "it is not good enough for God." Jesus himself was a carpenter for 30 years before starting formal ministry. Was his work as a carpenter a waste of his time? No, God was working his job well and was preaching good news even then; this tells us all that we do can be glorifying to God.

Introduction

Sometimes work is hard, but with due diligence it is God who will bring satisfaction to our labor. It is by God's grace that we are what we are. It is helpful to understand that all work gets done by God's grace and our hard work, both. Work and grace are meant to be friends, it is God's grace that enables us to work hard and well. Work is not a necessary evil, it is a blessing. We get the idea of work from God who is a working creator. Work is more than what you get paid to do. .
