Week 30 – ACTS 10:44-48

A Salvation that is Bigger Than Us

The early church father Augustine once said the real problem we have in our lives is not the rules we are breaking or not breaking, but “inordinate love,” meaning we love the wrong things...or even love the right things wrongly. As an example, you can love your nation (which can be a good thing), but if you love your nation more than anything in the world (including God), that can lead to racism and militarism. Augustine says there isn’t anything wrong with loving your nation; it’s when we love God less than anything else (children, job, spouse). He says the only way that we will ever be healed is if we love God more than anything (including ourselves).

In what ways have you loved yourself more than Jesus?

How have you trusted your own view of yourself (whether elevating yourself or demeaning yourself) over the truth of what God has said about you?

What is true about you in light of the Gospel?

Read Matthew 18:3.

What does childlike faith look like?

Why do you think it is important that Jesus reminds us to have childlike faith?

There are two simple reasons God gives us money and things:

1. To enjoy them. It is not a sin to have fun with the money you have; as a matter of fact, the scriptures repeatedly tell us that our pleasure and joy come from the right hand of God. It’s fine to sleep in a nice bed, wear comfortable shoes, and eat nice meals with your family. The problem arises when we close our hands and make our pleasure all about us.
2. To be generous and share. Some of God’s blessings we enjoy, and some we put into others’ hands. We are to understand that we are not simply receivers, but also givers; God has entrusted His stuff to us so we could distribute and share it. God’s goodness is meant to flow through us to others.

How do you strike a balance between generosity and enjoyment of your money/stuff?

In what ways would you say money has its “hooks” in you?

In what ways do you currently serve that god?

MISSION

Where is your treasure currently stored?

How is God trustworthy with financial matters even in spite of our fears?

What would it look like for you to enjoy your money and be generous with it at the same time?
