Week 43 Where Did Paul (And Where Do We) Go From Here

BIG IDEA:

The message of Acts is that God has sent us to "Herald Evangelion," meaning: to tell the good news. The best news of all is that Jesus is Lord! He lived sinlessly yet died the death that we deserve so that our names can be written in the book of life. We are citizens of God's Kingdom; Children of the Creator. That motivation should directly shape how we live and how we proclaim who God is and what He has done, so as many people as possible might come to put their faith in Him.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

What do you think God is accomplishing right now, even in the midst of elections and pandemics?

What happens when something good happens in your life? Do you want to tell others about it?

What is something good that has happened recently?

Spend some time explaining the Gospel to each other in your own words.

What is the difference between the Gospel and the implications of the Gospel?

What have been the implications of how (by grace) you have partaken in the benefits of the Gospel?

How can sharing the implications of the Gospel only, lead to misunderstanding the Gospel?

Do you tend to focus more on missions globally, locally, or at all? Do you rejoice in your own self-image or in Christ and who He says you are?

What is God calling you to do with your life?

How can you further develop your missionary skills? (Element U!)

Spend some time in prayer asking for God's heart towards people in your life. Pray that you gain a passion for seeing the lost become children of their Heavenly Father, despite what you might have to sacrifice.
