Week 4: Acts 13:13-43 The Gospel For Hebrews

BIG IDEA:

Paul speaks the same Gospel message in different contexts by learning His audience and explaining it in a way that they can understand.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Do you see anything different in how Paul and Peter present the Gospel message?

Why was it important for Paul to understand his audience?

What is it that the Hebrews believed/knew before Paul started speaking to them?

Why did Paul go back to Exodus? How does Exodus relate to Jesus?

In your own words, what is the Exodus story, and what does it represent for us today?

Why is it that this message speaks directly to the Hebrews greatest need and desire?

In your own words, what does Egypt represent in Scripture, and what in your life can you identify as your "Egypt?"

Do you believe in God's promise that He has heard your cry over your "Egypt?"

How is that possible?

How does Jesus redeem you? (If someone is unsure, encourage them with truth)

Do you have faith that Jesus welcomes you home?

How does that shape your eternity, beginning today?

What if Paul hadn't used the Egypt story to the Hebrews, do you think they would have been encouraged?

Spend time thanking God for wanting to bring you out of your Egypt. Acknowledge that there still will probably be consequences you will have to deal with, but that His Redemption is greater than that suffering. Week 4: Acts 13:13-43
