BIG IDEA:

The Gospel is both good and bad news – bad in the fact that it shines a light on the devastation of our sin, and beautifully good in the fact that it engulfs suffering and brings true joy because of what Jesus did for us. We can rest knowing that evil is defeated which brings hope, rejoicing, and fuels us to spread the Gospel as much as we can.
