

Week 5: Acts 13:44-52
The Gospel In A Cultural Context

BIG IDEA:

God's Good News is for all people. Paul spent time studying the culture so he can speak the unchanging Gospel Truths contextually – just like we are to do today.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- In your own words, what is the Good News (Gospel)?
- In what ways have you seen the gospel watered down and defined by culture?
- How would you explain the Gospel differently to your family versus your friends?
- What are key elements to Jesus' story that needs to be there so that the Gospel is not watered down?
- If you have already submitted your life to Jesus, who spoke the Gospel into your life?
- As Aaron explained in the message, what was the "trigger" where Jesus made sense OF you (your life) - where in turn, He made sense to you?
- Have you ever spoken from your cultural context to someone else, and they didn't completely understand?
- Has God's Spirit laid anyone on your heart to pray for that you desperately want(ed) to see come to know Jesus?
- Has the Gospel become such good news for you that you want everyone to hear it?
- Would you say you care about people and the Gospel enough to do the homework of understanding our culture, like Paul does?
- How can we do our homework to better understand someone's life experiences?
- Is there a way we can help each other practice speaking the Gospel? How can we as a community accomplish this together?
