## Week 19: Acts 18:1-11

### Fear Not - Do Not Be Silent - I Am With You

## BIG IDEA:

There is much to learn from how God responds when Paul reaches a point of being exhausted, tired and depressed. God promises three things 1) Fear not, 2) Do not be silent, and 3) I am with you. These promises are written for our benefit so we would understand and trust God.

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Have you ever been in a "funk" like Paul finds himself in these verses?

What do you do when you are in a funk (does it look different right now due to COVID-19)?

How has God brought encouragement during the last few weeks?

What encouragement do you think God is giving you through these verses?

What does it mean to "go for the low hanging fruit," when sharing the Gospel?

Can you identify anyone in your life who is "ripe" fruit?

Why does "kicking the dust off" only work if you trust that God, not us, is the one who brings people into the harvest?

Discuss God's words, "Fear not," and its implications for Paul's life and your's today.

Discuss God's promise, "I am with you," and its implications for Paul's life and your's today.

In what ways/how has God reminded you of who He is?

In what ways have you continued serving Jesus regardless of your feelings or circumstances on the horizon?
