The Way of The Way

BIG IDEA:

In Ephesus, Paul and the early disciples changed the economic landscape of the whole city by presenting a new way of living. They were called 'The Way' because the Christian life was a way of living that encompassed all of life: love, forgiveness, and worship. Today, we too are called into The Way, following God's example of what He has already done, empowered by the Holy Spirit.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

What are our modern idols that we (us or others) worship?
How does the reality of Jesus call people to come out of idolatry?
Could that have an economic impact on our city?

Why is it that when we find ourselves invested in Jesus, and with a greater understanding of the Gospel, our lives will be radically challenged?

In what ways are we FOR Jesus instead of simply being AGAINST other things?

Have you ever become desensitized to sin?

Are you doing some things that you once hated?

In what ways are you similar and in what ways are you distinguishable from our culture?

What is 'The Way' that we see the early church go by?

How can the way of 'The Way' change the world as a result of the Gospel today?

What does it look like for you, personally, to walk in The Way?

Explain how you think we should be living, and why?

What is God's example?

What needs to change in your life if you were to follow the Way of God's example?

Who are you called to be?
