DISCUSSION

Think of someone in your life, other than a significant other or parent, who made you feel valued. How did he or she do that?

EXPLANATION

How do the social norms of our culture reflect God's value of human beings and how do they fail to reflect it? How well did the Declaration of Independence reflect God's value for all people?

Where did it fall short?

In what way is the Gospel of Jesus Christ the only reality for understanding anyone's or anythings proper place in God's creation?

APPLICATION Read Matthew 6:26 & Matthew 10:29–31 What do these parables about animals tell us about God's love for each person?

MISSION

In what ways do you try to value others in the way that God values them?

How is valuing others a struggle for you?

How can you communicate worth to each person you meet as you go through your day?

Think of someone in your life whom you have difficulty valuing. Pray for that person daily for a week, asking God how you might need to grow in how you see them.
