AMOS

Prophesied 8th Century BC (during the reign of Uzziah, king of Judah and Jeroboam, King

Occupation - farmer and rancher. Town - Tekoa (10 miles south of Jerusalem).

Amos did not consider himself a prophet but instead a "grower of Sycamore figs" and a shepherd.

Amos was tired of his country's sin and complacency. His spoke against the ways his country exploited the poor and needy.
