HABAKKUK

Prophesied 7th – 6th Century BC (most likely 605-598 BC).

Prophesied when Babylon was the undisputed world power.

He is one of the few that calls himself a “prophet.”

Habakkuk pictures a frustrated prophet who channeled his frustration into prayers and eventually praise to God, rather than trying to run from the Lord.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Take some time to think about what lies at the heart of every human culture. Why do we tend to focus on ourselves, so readily, instead of God?

What does it mean that “the line between good and evil runs down the center of every human heart?”

How do we forget who God is when we think our answers to the world's problems are our answers and not “His name going forth?”
