HABAKKUK

Prophesied 7th – 6th Century BC (most likely 605-598 BC).

Prophesied when Babylon was the undisputed world power.

He is one of the few that calls himself a “prophet.”

Habakkuk pictures a frustrated prophet who channeled his frustration into prayers and eventually praise to God, rather than trying to run from the Lord.

What things do you find that you remember the most (past failures, past happiness)?

Do you ever find yourself, in the midst of trouble, remembering what God did in Jesus for you?

How could we (practically) remind one another of the Gospel in trying times?
