

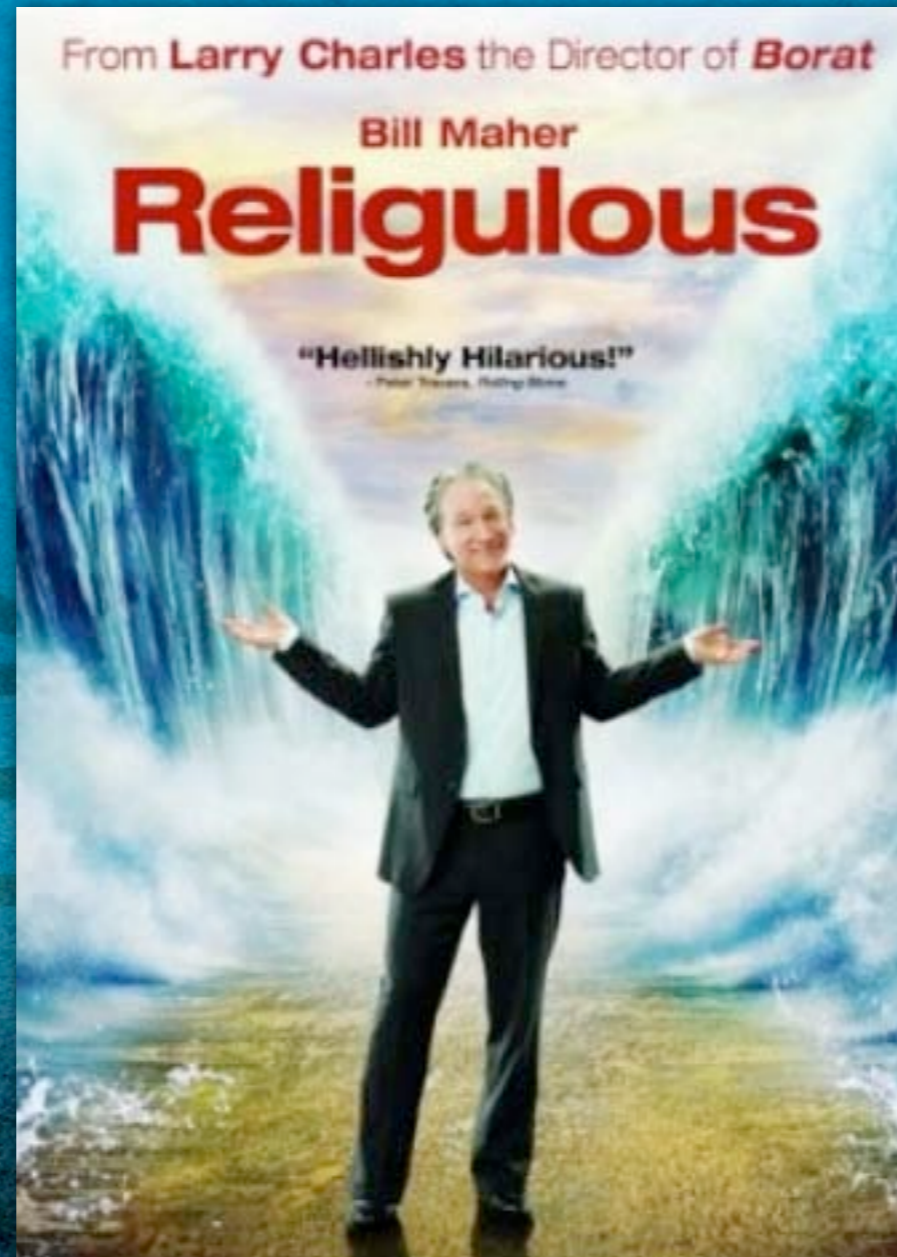

Matthew → Jews → Messiah King fulfills law

- Genealogy to Abraham & David → 60% Jesus' words
- 30 OT prophecies fulfilled → God called Father 46x's

Includes Virgin Birth

Mark → Romans → Who He was → Servant

- Divided into Jesus' deeds & death → 18/35 of Jesus' miracles
- no genealogy → Little attention to 1st 30 years of Jesus' life

Does not include Virgin Birth

Luke → Gentiles → Perfect Man → Historical

- Genealogy traced to Adam → 50% Jesus' words → Jewish traits
- Emphasis on Grace → Jesus' emotions highlighted

Includes Virgin Birth

John → Greeks → Uses metaphors → Few Old Testament quotes

- Many Old Testament allusions → 90% unique
- No parables → I Am statements - *Jesus' divinity*
- Re-appropriation of Greek concepts
