BIG IDEA:

We all try to hide our failures because we want to be loved, but that hiding is what keeps us from experiencing true love. We hide because we think if someone truly knew us there is no way they would love/like us. But we can never truly love one another without being fully known.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

What is, how would you define, FAMILY? How does the trinity help us see that at His core, God is relational? Describe a time you felt like you belonged in a community of people?

Do you have any experience where you wanted to belong, but you ended up hiding who you truly were?

Do you believe, as a Christian, you are a part of God's new family?

God's solution to loneliness is the church. How have you found this to be true or untrue? How could "the church" (Element) do better? How can you be a part of the solution for others? In what ways might God be calling you to help other's in their loneliness? What does it mean to truly welcome others into your life?

How can we best disciple one-another through practical life together? How does confession, prayer, and healing go together in the practical every-day stuff of life?

Reflecting on 2020 and the COVID lock down, how can we improve welcoming outsiders and fight loneliness within the church?

Read James 5:16.

What do you need to confess to one another in order for others to truly SEE you, and ACCEPT you so you can better belong?
