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BIG IDEA:

The type of culture much of the Bible was written in was one that focused upon honor and shame. American culture is what is known as an individualistic culture. An individualistic culture tends to be a right/wrong culture (innocence versus guilt). An honor/shame culture is not focused on an individual, but the community. Right and wrong in both cultures will be viewed differently, but God will use both types of cultures to speak of Himself and draw us to Himself.

What shame does David bring upon himself during the story?

Why does God send a prophet to David?

Have you ever experienced shame?

Do you still carry it or has it been dealt with in Christ? If so, how?

How does God speak into the honor/shame culture to bring about His glory and their good?

How is the Gospel spoken into this moment?

Read Psalm 51.

What is David's response?

How does David repent of sin and worship God?

What does David mean when he says, "Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me."?

How can we also be restored?
